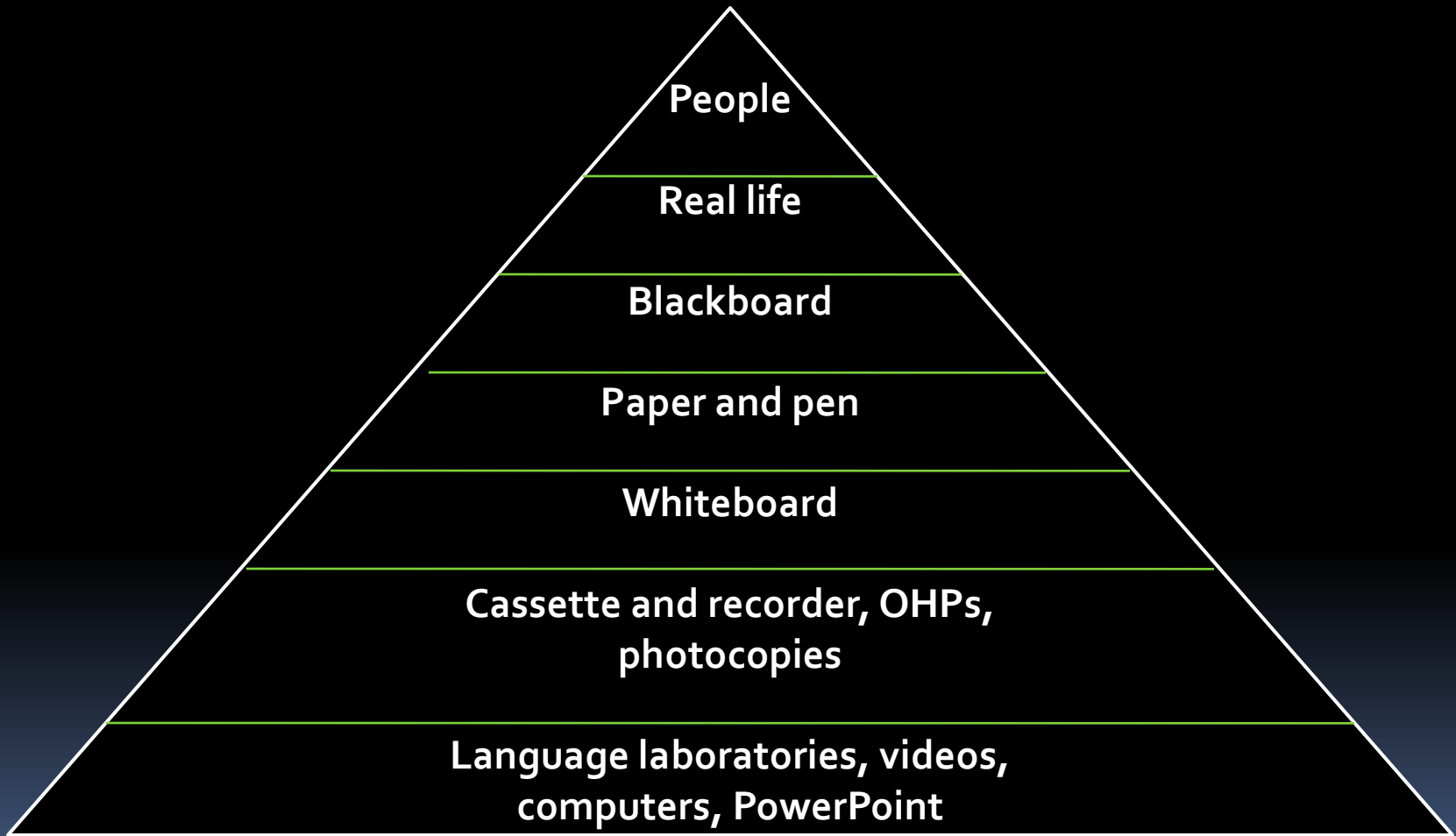

Uses of PowerPoint in the Classroom

- Initial teaching: Teaching new ideas and concept
 - Practice and drill
 - Review
 - Test
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Research Procedure

- Subject: 12 pre-service teachers
- Observation
- Document analysis: lesson plan, power point
- Interview: perception and testimony

Findings


The use

- Initial teaching: explanation
- Practice and drill: instruction combined with worksheet
- Review: text
- Tests:
- Hyperlink: video, song, pictures

Interaction: teacher's talk, teacher-student involvement, student-student




Challenges

- Technical aspects: computers/laptop, projectors, power supply
 - Skills: prepare, operate, time awareness
 - Resources
 - Availability
 - Comfort zone: body position, media in charge?

 - Lesson planning is important
